COMPLAINT



1. Jurisdiction and venue are proper in this Court.
2. That on or about 10/25/2019, Plaintiff purchased certain accounts from Citibank, N.A. Defendant obligated on one of those accounts as more specifically described below. The account was duly assigned, in the normal course of business, to Plaintiff.
3. Upon information and belief, Defendant has possession of the contract upon which this claim is based.
4. Plaintiff and/or its assignor completed performance under the terms and conditions of the account.
5. Defendant has defaulted under the terms and conditions of the account by failing to pay as promised.
